- I will not control, possess, or consume alcohol or any drugs.
- I will not participate in or permit any criminal behavior or activity.
- Because we are responsible for our individual and group behavior, I will report any breach of this Code by me or anyone else to a person of authority.
- If I breach any part of this Code, I am subject to discipline and may:
 - ❖ be required to compensate someone and/or
 - ❖ lose all or part of my privilege to attend camp, may be asked to leave camp, and/or be a member of my Group or Scouts Canada.
